Over the last ten years he has focused on black and white watercolour and drawing to explore the primeval process of forest and landscape on Waiheke Island where he now lives.

His fascination with watercolour was the result of a research visit to London in 2012 and this medium's layered transparency is evident in his recent return to acrylics and colour. His early stencil-making experience in printmaking has informed the technical development in his current painting methods.

Clive graduated from Kingston College of Art and Design, London, in 1970. Since then, he has exhibited extensively. In 2015, he was the recipient of a National Tertiary Teaching Excellence Award and awarded an Honorary Master of Fine Arts in 2020.






Tryst (Whakanewha), 2021 Acrylic on canvas, 1000mm x 800mm


Halo (Whakanewha, 2021 Acrylic on canvas, 800mm x 1000mm




III Shade (Whakanewha), 2021 Acrylic on canvas, 1000mm x 800mm
